Applied Security Institute may, from time to time, with prior notice modify, amend, or supplement the Terms of Service. If you are registering on behalf of a company, you declare that you have the right and authorisation to do so.

1 TERMS AND DEFINITIONS

1. The agreement considering subscriptions is created between:
 - a. Applied Security Institute Ltd. (“ABI” or “We”), the owner and operator of www.abibiometrics.org, holder of copyrights and the trademarks associated with the website.
 - b. The “Subscriber”, who subscribes and pays for the full access rights of www.abibiometrics.org
2. Other statuses
 - a. A “Visitor” or “Guest” is someone, who accesses the free content available on www.abibiometrics.org, without subscription.
 - b. A “Registered user” is a customer with an expired subscription. This status is equal to the Subscriber status in all senses, except that a registered user has the same limited access to the content as visitors. Registered users may become Subscribers again, upon purchasing a new subscription. For all intents and purposes, where restricted content is not of question, subscribers encompass registered users as well.
 - c. “Users” are the colloquial term that encompasses all visitors, registered users and subscribers.
3. Contents
 - a. The “website” is www.abibiometrics.org and all of its subdomains
 - b. “Content” is the colloquial term that encompasses both normal and restricted content
 - c. The “normal content” encompasses all the materials available on the website for any visitor.
 - d. The “restricted content” encompasses the materials only available for Subscribers.

2 THE PRODUCT, AVAILABILITY AND WARRANTY

1. The product you purchase is the 365 day subscription to www.abibiometrics.org that allows you non-exclusive access to the restricted content.
 - a. The service is considered complete when the access rights are granted for the subscriber.
 - b. Any advice given by ABI to a customer (if not done as a paid service) is considered free support, and as such, ABI can’t be held liable about it.
2. Due to the nature of the internet, while cannot guarantee it, ABI does it's best to maintain server operation at all times. Should any lasting downtime occur, we will compensate our subscribers by extending their subscription time accordingly.
 - a. Although ABI makes great effort to keep the site clean of malicious codes, it cannot be held liable for any damages caused by viruses, trojans or similar events.
3. Should the Subscriber decide to cancel the subscription before expiration, the subscriber may get a full refund of the amount payed. Subscribers can request this from support@abibiometrics.org.

3 ACCOUNT, PERSONAL DATA AND CONTACT INFORMATION

1. ABI – for registration purposes – collects personal information from the user: Name, Billing address, Job title and Company name.

2. User accounts may not be shared.
 - a. It is the duty of the user to guarantee that the account is not compromised, and to protect it with a proper password.
 - b. ABI staff will never ask for your password and does not store it in a human readable form.
3. Official contact between ABI and subscribers is done by e-mail. Users are required to provide a working e-mail address as part of the registration. ABI considers that e-mail address as the official contact channel until it is changed.
 - a. It is the duty of the user to guarantee that the provided e-mail address works at all times. ABI is not liable for any loss of information because of an inoperative e-mail address.
4. Any problems regarding the account, inquiries and official matters must be handled exclusively in a written form.

4 USAGE AND OWNERSHIP OF THE CONTENT

1. General rules
 - a. ABI is the sole copyright holder for the content posted on the website (except for materials where it is expressly stated otherwise)
 - b. All content (including the organization and presentation of such content) on this website are the property of ABI and may be protected by intellectual property laws including laws relating to copyrights, trade-marks, trade-names, internet domain names, and other similar rights.
 - c. The Materials may only be used and copied for your own, non-commercial, personal or educational purposes, provided that the Materials are not modified and that copyright and other intellectual property notices are not deleted. You may not create derivative works from or otherwise exploit the Materials in any way.
 - d. Redistribution of any content, especially for business purposes is strictly forbidden.
 - e. Within the bounds of [fair use](#), users may publicly copy excerpts of our research for criticism, news reporting, teaching, etc., but must notify ABI institute, and may not modify the material.
 - f. Any other non-personal uses require ABIs express, written permission.
 - g. Users may create a backup copy of the downloaded content, if required.
2. Rules for the restricted content
 - a. Subscribers with an active subscription are free to read and access any number of reports at any time as many times as they want, however:
 - i. Subscribers cancelling their accounts must delete all digital copies and destroy all paper based copies held of the restricted contents and may not use them after the subscription is cancelled.
 - ii. Registered users may keep the restricted content they obtained during the subscription period and may also keep a backup copy. If, for some reason a registered user loses such content, ABI will not replace it, the only way to gain it back in this case is to subscribe again.

5 PAYMENT

1. Any applicable fees and other charges are payable in advance and must be done either through our online POS terminal or bank transfer.

- a. Our online POS terminal is operated by Wirecard Central Eastern Europe GmbH. With such payments, their data security directive and privacy policy is governing. This payment method usually takes only a few seconds, and access right activation to the restricted content is nearly instant after returning from the POS to our website. Invoices are sent out electronically, through e-mail.
 - b. The Bank transfer payment method places an order for the subscription with ABI. Prospective subscribers shall get an invoice electronically, through e-mail, with which fees may be paid. After the bank transfer has arrived to ABI (which may take days depending on the bank and geographical location), the subscription shall be activated by ABI, with subscription status updated on the profile and informing the subscriber by e-mail. Any fees that may incur during bank transfer is payable by the customer.
 - c. Currently, subscribers can only extend subscriptions while the previous one is active through bank transfers. POS users must wait until the subscription expires and then initiate the next one.
 - d. There is no automatic continuation of subscription. After expiration, users must initiate another subscription and payment cycle. ABI will never charge credit cards or bank accounts automatically.
 - e. ABI staff will never ask you for your credit card and/or bank account information.
2. Every price displayed (if not stated otherwise) is in Euros (€) and without VAT. Any incurring VAT is payable by the customer.

7 BREACH OF THE TERMS

1. ABI may – with notifying the customer – may one-sidedly end the subscription without the possibility of refund, and with the right reserved for legal action if a subscriber breaches these terms of service, especially if:
 - a. Illegally sharing the account
 - b. Illegally distributing the contents
 - c. Using the content for business purposes (e.g. reselling)
 - d. Keeping copies without permission after either account cancellation or forced account deletion
 - e. Reproducing ABI design without permission in any way
